The Central Pennsylvania Chapter of PIAA Football Officials was organized as the Football Officials Association of Central Pennsylvania on September 12, 1929. First president of the group was E. C. Taggart. E. E. "Shorty" Miller was vice president and H. R. Davis, secretary-treasurer.

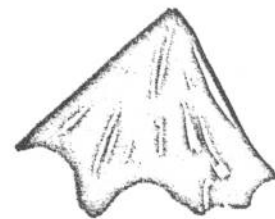
For many years, the Association served all of Central Pennsylvania and many of the well-known officials still with us were at one time members. Tag was president for six years. Shorty for seven and Jim Peifer and Clarence Beck for shorter terms.

In 1945 the Association received its charter and became a chapter of PIAA Football Officials. In 1946 Jim Peifer again was elected president and held the office until September 1953 when he was succeeded by Don Enders. Don served three years and was followed by J. Harold Thomas, who also served three years. Dick Shover was elected president in 1959, Phil Roudensky in 1960, Jack Bogar in 1961 and Paul Marinak in 1962.

Throughout the Chapter's 34-year history, it has had only four Secretaries. H. R. Davis served only one year and was followed by Louis Sheffer, who held the post until 1938. Ralph Farina held the office continuously for 17 years. He was succeeded by Severino Stefanon, who was elected secretary in November 1953 and has held the office since.

The Chapter meets every Monday night during the season to discuss play situations and review the Rules of Football. The Chapter served all of the midstate area, going as far west as Altoona, north to Williamsport, east to Reading and south into Maryland. The Chapter handles teachers college assignments as well as high school games.

Phil Raudensky - Chapter officer. Phil's concentration on rules and hustle served as an example for young officials.

Sev Stefanon - Held both secretary and treasurer posts for 10 years. Sev worked long and hard with school officials to gain chapter assignments. Increased services were provided to area schools under Sev's capable leadership. He left a well organized system upon his retirement.

Joe Mulligan - Former chapter officer and oldest active official in age. Joe personifies desire, mental alertness and physical fitness in Football officiating.

Fred Bennett - Chapter secretary for more years than anyone else in chapter history. Handles assignments for several high school leagues and provides excellent procedures to bring young officials to maturity in their careers.

Len Czarnecki - Former chapter officer and presently Official's Representative in District III for the last 8 years. Len does a great deal of leg work in chapter business. One of the founders of the Collegiate Officials Athletic Association, he is presently Director of the Collegiate Officials Sports Service which is experiencing steady growth under his leadership.

Reed Ernst - Former chapter officer and rules interpreter. Reed also serves on the P. I. A. A. Board of Control as the representative of the Pennsylvania Association of School Administrators.

Jack Bogar - Former chapter officer and always available to take over rules interpretation meeting at a moment's notice. Jack serves as a steady influence for younger officials.

Les Reichert - Chapter officer and more recently has assumed responsibility for partial game assignments. Les has always played a major role in banquet preparations.

Bob Gallagher - Chapter treasurer for the last ten years. Bob has helped provide positive leadership as a member of the executive board during this time.

Charles McCullough - A most welcome addition to the Harrisburg area. When he arrived from Baltimore in 1962 few could realize his influence would match or outdo his size on the sports scene. Charlie left an impression everywhere he worked. He soon became the "top" referee in the area. He served the chapter in various offices but became "its" rules interpreter. No other Football chapter in the State had more up-to-date rulings than we had. His astute knowledge and study of the rules lead him to an administrative post in the P. I. A. A. His organizational talents took him and many other officials of this chapter through a succession of semi-pro Football circuits. His appointment as Executive Director of the P. I. A. A. thrust him onto the national scene in Football rules formulation. From this position he has been instrumental in significant rules changes which have often been discussed within our chapter meetings. We have been most fortunate to have had a man of his talent continue his association with us. His emphasis on technique and mechanics constantly reminds all those who work with him. At present he has expanded his rules interpretation responsibilities to various surrounding states and is at the zenith of his profession. We are most proud that he still considers ours "his" chapter. Under his leadership we had been the experimenters for new ideas in Football rules. Even with his multi-faceted responsibilities of running the P. I. A. A., Charlie finds time each year to get our chapter ready for each new season. We give you a thank you as big as you are in your profession.

It is obvious that a list of this nature could be expanded even further and it is very possible that omissions have been made, but certainly not intended. To these men here cited and to others go the credit for bringing our chapter, in our first 50 years, to a position of great respect in our State. The challenge to the young men of our chapter is very simple. To maintain the quality of leadership now current will require the same dedication to excellence which has brought us our present status.

Drawing upon the successful experiences of the past will prove to be helpful, but development of new techniques will be necessary. Let us pledge tonight to commit the membership of this chapter to maintain and expand the pride, reputation and accomplishments of the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of P. I. A. A. Football Officials.

CHAPTER HISTORY 1928-1978

As we celebrate, on this occasion, fifty years of service to Pennsylvania Football it is note worthy to reflect on our early trials, our past achievements and our future aspirations. The history of the Central Pennsylvania Chapter of P.I. A. A. Football Officials is long and illustrious. From its fledgling year in 1928 with few members and few schools to serve we have grown in numbers and expanded our scope of influence far beyond our local area. Early two and three man crews have been replaced with five man crews in most games. Our chapter membership of over one hundred is one of the largest in Pennsylvania. The quality performance of our chapter officials is widely recognized as is evidenced by the ever increasing call for our men to go into other areas to officiate "big games." Over the years our chapter has demonstrated a sensitivity to the need for various rule changes. In a logical manner problems in rules were discussed, changes were proposed and in some cases amendments and additions became part of the National Federation rules used to administer high school Football throughout the country today; thus, our influence has made an impact on the game far beyond that of other officials' groups. Because of these contributions leadership status is ours.

A review of our chapter's history shows we have had more than our share of strong leaders. A list of these outstanding officials would include those who have played an instrumental part at one time or another in the chapter's growth and recognition. Although, in some cases, they are no longer active in officiating, their influence remains. We honor them as our distinguished alumni.

Bill Doremus - Outstanding college official.

Ralph Farina - Long time secretary-treasurer of the early organization.

Jim Peifer - Chapter President and leader for many years.

W. E. Nitrauer - Powerful influence in athletics in District III and the Officials' Representative.

E. E. "Shorty" Miller - Outstanding college official.

J. Harold Thomas - Former President and oldest active member of the chapter. Tommy began his officiating career in 1940.

Ivy Sherman - Left his mark on many area athletes and brother officials with his positive attitude and "God Bless You."

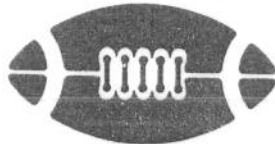

OFFICIAL'S CHECKLIST

Below are some points to keep in mind when officiating sports at any level. All officials must have a good working knowledge of the rules and mechanics. In addition to this, very successful officials have an understanding of the human relations aspect of their jobs.

- BE COMPETITIVE** — the players give maximum effort, so should you. Tell yourself, "I'm not going to let this game get away from me. I am better than that." You are hired to make the calls that control the game — Make Them!
- HAVE YOUR HEAD ON RIGHT** — Don't think your striped shirt grants you immunity from having to take a little criticism. It's part of officiating. Plan on it. Successful officials know how much to take. Ask one when you get the chance.
- DON'T BE A TOUGH GUY** — If a coach is on your back but not enough to warrant a penalty, then stay away from him (or her). This is especially true during time-outs. Standing near an unhappy coach, just to "show him," will only lead to further tensions. Some officials develop irritating characteristics. Don't be one of them.
- GET INTO THE FLOW OF THE GAME** — Each game is different. Good officials can feel this difference. Concentrate on the reactions of the players. Take note if the tempo of the game changes. A ragged game calls for a different style of officiating from a smooth one.
- DON'T BARK** — If you don't like to be shouted at, don't shout at someone else. Be firm with a normal relaxed voice. This technique will do wonders in helping you to reduce the pressure. Shouting indicates a loss of control — not only of one's self, but also of the game.
- SHOW CONFIDENCE** — Cockiness has absolutely no place in officiating. You want to exude confidence. Your presence should command respect from the participants. As in any walk of life, appearance, manner, and voice determine how you are accepted. Try to present the proper image.
- FORGET THE FANS** — As a group, fans usually exhibit three characteristics: ignorance of the rules, highly emotional partisanship and delight in antagonizing the officials. Accepting this fact will help you ignore the fans, unless they interrupt the game or stand in the way of you during your job.
- ANSWER REASONABLE QUESTIONS** — Treat coaches and players in a courteous way. If they ask you a question reasonably, answer them in a polite way. If they get your ear by saying "Hey ref I want to ask you something," and then start telling you off, interrupt and remind them of the reason for the discussion. Be firm, but relaxed.
- CHOOSE YOUR WORDS WISELY** — Don't obviously threaten a coach or player. This will only put them on the defensive. More importantly, you will have placed yourself on the spot. If you feel a situation is serious enough to warrant a threat, then it is serious enough to penalize, without invoking a threat. Obviously some things you say will be a form of threat, but using the proper words can make it subtle.
- STAY COOL** — Your purpose is to establish a calm environment for the game. Nervous or edgy officials are easily spotted by fans, coaches and players alike. Avidly chewing gum, pacing around, or displaying a wide range of emotions prior to or during a game will serve to make you seem vulnerable to the pressure.
