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1. As the clock is running down in the 2nd quarter, A10 completes a long pass down the middle of the field to TE A88. A88 is downed inbounds. Team A is attempting to spike the ball as the clock is under 5 seconds in the half and running. QBA10 receives the hand to hand snap and immediately spikes the ball forward into the ground with 2 seconds remaining in the half. When the ball was snapped, all 11 players on offense were inadvertently not set for 1 second. This was a 3rd down and 2 from the B-20. What is the correct ruling if foul is accepted?
